Apply for Marie Skłodowska-Curie Postdoctoral Fellowship (PF) and European Research Area Fellowship (ERA –PF)

under the EU Horizon Europe Programme **with the University of Warsaw!**

The University of Warsaw is a leading Polish university located in the capital of Poland, one of the most dynamically developing academic cities in Europe, holding high positions in international rankings. Warsaw is the centre of political and economic life and has a lively social and cultural scene. **Among ca. 47,8 thousand students the University community includes 4 800 foreigners: students and doctoral students from over 100 countries, and 7500 employees. The University employs 3 800 scholars whose scientific enquiry extends over 3 350 research topics; students who they concurrently teach have the opportunity of joining in their research projects, including [the prestigious ERC grants](#). The University's research teams have won [worldwide recognition in many areas of knowledge](#) and have joined international research programmes (with over 200 running projects/year). If you are an experienced researcher interested in your scientific career development by working @theUniversityofWarsaw apply for the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Postdoctoral Fellowship or ERA Postdoctoral Fellowship with the University of Warsaw by 14/09/2022!

Basic principles:

- 1) **The Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA)**, named after the double Nobel Prize winning Polish-French scientist famed for her work on radioactivity, support researchers of any nationality.
- 2) **Researchers working across all disciplines**, from life-saving healthcare to 'blue-sky' science, are eligible for funding. The MSCA offers fellowships and enables to undertake an original and personalized research and innovation project.
- 3) **The objective** is to improve researchers' employability and career prospects within academia and beyond, with a strong focus on interdisciplinarity and intersectoral experience.

Postdoctoral Fellowships and ERA Fellowships @theUniversityofWarsaw

Who can apply?

This action is meant to support the **best, most promising individual, experienced researchers** from anywhere in the world, holding **doctoral degree, with a maximum of 8 years of full-time equivalent in research** by the time of the call **deadline – 14/09/2022**.

Researchers must comply with the mobility rule:

Researchers **may not** have resided or carried out their main activity (**work, studies**, etc.) **in the country of their host organisation for more than 12 months in the 3 years** immediately before the call deadline 14/09/2022.

What can be funded?

Mobility across borders is a must. Cross-sectoral mobility is also encouraged.

What does the funding cover?

The grant provides an **allowance to cover your living, travel and family costs**. The grant is awarded to your host organisation, usually a university, research centre or a company in Europe.

*A country correction coefficient (CCC) applies to the living allowance in order to ensure equal treatment and purchasing power parity for all researchers. CCC for Poland is 70,5% and base amount is 5080€

How long does the Fellowship last?

Fellowships last from **12 to 24 months (European Postdoctoral Fellowships)** or **24 to 36 months (Global Postdoctoral Fellowships)**.

Who decides?

Postdoctoral Fellowships and ERA Postdoctoral Fellowships are selected through an **open competition and transparent, independent evaluation by the independent experts hired by the European Commission from all over Europe and beyond.**

How do I apply?

You submit a **research proposal**, including your CV. The proposal is **written jointly with your chosen host organization -> the University of Warsaw!**
